Sub: Grant of conditional permission to “Prabuddh Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Gram Bakka Khera, Mall Malihabad Road, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh” with 50 seats in UG (BAMS) Course for the academic session 2018-19 under Section 13A/13C of the IMCC Act, 1970 - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. R.12011/09/2013-EP (IM-1) for 2017-18 dated 14.08.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the 2018-19 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 06.02.2018 and re-visited on 21-22.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that the college was having certain deficiencies as per RMS 2016 viz., Only 9515 books are available in the library against the requirement of 10000 books, Web based computerized central registration system, Functional Clinical Laboratory, X-Ray, ECG and USG, Quality Testing Laboratory and Aadhaar based geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff and hospital staff. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college to present the case on 16.08.2018 and 12.10.2018 vide Ministry's letter dated 09.08.2018 & 08.10.2018 respectively.

3. The observations of hearing committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached

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Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder & as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) and it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS).

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission to Prabuddh Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & Research Centre, Gram Bakka Khera, Mall Malihabad Road, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh** to take admissions for **50 seats** in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by 31st December, 2018:

- i. Functional Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and hospital staff and
- ii. Functional USG facility.


5. In addition; following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:-

- (i) all the relevant requirements of Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 ;
- (ii) all the relevant requirements under the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

6. The fulfillment of the deficiencies pointed out in the Assessment Report of CCIM and hearing committee (if any) and the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.

7. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
